COMMUNITY DAY PROGRAMME

Claud Switzer Memorial Trust realises that people living in rural areas need access to the support provided by community day programmes.

The Switzer dementia specific day programme is known as the "Alz Club". It is a fun day out for the person with dementia and a well deserved day off for carers.

ACCESS to the ALZ CLUB

Subsidised attendance is by referral via your GP Practice who will forward a referral to The NASC Team.

Club membership is free of charge for those approved by NASC however you can privately fund at a cost of \$50 per day (or \$55 including transport within Kaitaia or \$60 including transport from Ahipara or the coast e.g. Mangonui) until your referral comes through.



If eligible for transport, collection will be between 8:30 - 9:30am and drop off 3:30 - 4:30pm depending on your location
